<i>Tenure</i> Each member of a Subcommittee shall hold office for a term of one (1) year but shall be eligible for re-appointment for a further term of 1 year if necessary.		
<i>Eligibility Requirements</i> Members of the following membership categories (ACTIVE SENIOR MEMBER, ACTIVE RESERVE MEMBER, LONG SERVICE MEMBER) who are current in their membership fees may nominate themselves for a position in the Subcommittee.		
<i>Appointment</i> Appointment to a position on a Subcommittee is subject to Executive Committee approval.		
Application for Expression of Interest All applications are to be submitted via email to <u>Secretary@newportsurfclub.com.au</u> and shall consist of a current Curriculum Vitae (CV) and a brief description of your reason/s for wishing to join the Subcommittee and how you may contribute.		
<i>Roles &amp; Responsibilities</i> A well thought-out, precisely written constitution is an essential foundation for an effective committee. Committees are to have a constitution that clearly describes the purpose and operation of the committee including membership, Chair, function, decision-making and communication lines, quorum and conduct of meetings.
