RESCUE BOARD FOR EMERGENCY USE

- Suggestion that a rescue board be added to the standing and always accessible rescue gear on the outside of the club.
- Photos below illustrate the Avalon solution
- Reasons for anyone who doesn't have a key. Rescues with tubes versus boards.
 One in club's front door is a 'half-measure' for when club front door is open, but beggars question of when door is closed.
- Possible reasons against. Worst case consequences consideration:
 - Loss of a rescue board ok
 - Illegitimate use of rescue board leading to a risky situation / harm to user...







FEE STRUCTURE RECOMENDATION

- 1. 1 only fee membership value.
 - a. \$100 is the value for an Active Kids Voucher
 - b. However, recommend using \$90 for all membership classes for current year, (and \$100 next year)
 - c. However, would also support a flat \$100 for this year, provided a hardship fund set aside for larger families...(as usual)
- 2. 1 only training fee value
 - a. Say \$170

Subject: NSLSC SERVICE HONOUR BOARDS

The purpose of this submission is to request that the Executive of the Newport Surf Life Saving Club (NSLSC) is for the NSLSC to install a new Veteran's Honour Board to honour Members who have served Australia in theatres of "warlike" operations post-Vietnam.

NSLSC has a proud tradition of recognising Members who have such service with the names of 95 on the current three Honour Boards.

It is also recommended to the NSLSC Executive that a new Regulation be adopted as to the eligibility for inclusion on the Board. A regulation is now required as many changes have replaced the former proof (Return from Active Service Badge #) as recognition by the Federal Government of eligible service. Changes in terminology so that a "day in uniform" is recognised by the Department of Veteran Affairs (DVA) as a "Veteran" further complicates the issue.

The proposed Regulation utilises the DVA recognition for "warlike" service to simplify eligibility. If potential candidates for the Honour Board have proof of being awarded this recognition, they are eligible. This will enable applicants and future family generations to determine eligibility and remove any potential inconsistencies.

There are currently four, possibly five NSLSC Members who have attained the required proof. NSLSC Michael King has generously constructed a Post Vietnam Honour Board. Additional costs will be incurred for the inscription and naming of the Board.

It is proposed that the Board be erected over the entrance to the kitchen hall. Naming and recognition conventions are covered in the proposed Regulation.

NEWPORT SURF LIFE SAVING CLUB Veteran Honour Board Eligibility

This Regulation purpose is to set out who is eligible for inclusion on the NSLSC Veteran Honour Boards. The Regulation utilises the recognition awarded by the Australian Government, via the Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) for service on "Warlike/Warlike Operations".

1. Membership Eligibility

The Candidate must have been a current Member as one of the following classes of NSLSC Membership.

- Active Senior
- Active Reserve
- Long Service
- Past Active
- Life Members

At the time commencement of service, conscription, or deployment to a 'warlike' operational theatre

2. Classification of Eligible Service

The Candidate must be in receipt of one of the following

- Australian Active Service Medal (AASM)
- Return from Active Service Badge (RASB)
- Operational Service Medal (OSM)¹
- Return from Operational Service Badge (ROSB)²

3. Proof Requirements

- 3.1 Applicant
 - Service Records including:
 - o RAS Badge #
 - PMKeys Read Out
- 3.2 Family (Where the Service person is deceased or incapacitated)
 - Badge/Medals details (including inscription on the reverse or rim of decoration device)
 - Death Certificate
 - Certified copies of Service records where available.
 - Discharge Certificate
 - o Service Record
 - Paybook
 - Anything else relevant to the Service Member
 - DVA Freedom of Information Form (FOI)

4. Approval Process

- 4.1 Applicant
 - Ensure Membership Eligibility
 - Cross reference Service/Badge/Documentation #'s
- 4.2 Family
 - Engage one of the Ex-Service Organisations (ESO's) to provide and Advocate certify the documents with DVA.
 - Northern Beaches District Council of Sub-Branches
 - Northern Beaches Legacy
 - Approval by NSLSC Board of Management
