Items, News, or Issues to report since last meeting

- For November, Club Bar revenue was \$20K (Compared to \$13K in Nov, and \$14K in Dec 23). Functions and events were good at \$11K (vs \$11K last year, but that included lunch for a cause of \$5K). There was the usual Hall hire \$1.3K, Interest, and clothing sales \$2.8K. \$1.5K of Nipper BBQ income, and there was \$500 correction to a sponsorship invoice from November. We received the \$7K donation from Rotary from the Beach to Beach which was received in October last year, so that corrects that timing difference. We also received \$8K from SLS NSW which was the annual compliance grant / donation This appears to have been received early as it was in Feb last year, so we're a little ahead of where we would be normally. \$55K Total revenue in the month. This compares to \$66K in Nov and \$47K in Dec 23).
- Main Variances to the Dec 23 result are the following: timing difference re the Donations from Rotary, and SLS NSW \$15 Positive. \$5K less in Pool to Peak income (likely a timing difference of a sponsorship invoice.
- Subscription income was \$3.3K in Dec and YTD is 92.5% of last year's YTD amount at \$82.6K vs \$89K Dec 23.
- Costs were \$43K vs \$45K last year. Pool to Peak costs were about \$2K less than Dec 23, so a likely timing difference there. Nipper BBQ Costs also appear low so there may be a timing difference there in receiving the invoices from Gavin. Bar costs were similar, but wages higher as busier, which is also the first month reflecting the new pricing. All Wages and Super were \$19K overall out of the \$43K.
- Normal operational expenses remain well controlled and include depreciation, R&M, cleaning, bank fees, rescue costs (Fuel, first aid) etc. There were some additional costs (\$300) to replace equipment used in the search and recovery operation. Training Costs were approx \$2K for first aid training relating to the Bronze course.
- There was a profit for the month of \$11.7K, and we are now in a net profit position YTD at \$22.6K. This compares to a YTD profit of \$26K last year. I would expect January to remain profitable due to the Pool to Peak swim and the busier period in the bar / functions. We will then likely return to losses, although with Branch Carnival being back at Newport that month should be close to break even.

Items, News, or Issues to report since last meeting

- Passing of Life member Col McLean
- DA Update Land and Environment court granted consent to the DA on 19/12, and they have directed the council to register the consent. This means that the we are now into the next phase of finding funding and driving towards a date for commencement. I will be meeting with council, councillors, state and federal members to work through the next steps.
- Out of interest the new set of documents includes a quantity Surveyor estimate which puts the cost at: 8.6M made up of Seawall 3.2M, Building 3.3M Fitout 1.1M, Demolition .3M, professional feels .35M. We are hoping to work on a similar model to recent club redevelopments where the club needs to cover the cost of the fitout.
- Sub committees- please advise of the makeup of your subcommittees for the year, this year a minimum of 4 meetings of each subcommittee will be expected as per the regulations and the minutes of the meetings should be available for the next board meeting.
- Search at Newport Sunday 15th December. As you would be aware we had a search at Newport that ended with a body being retrieved. Feedback on the way the search was conducted has been very positive. As a club, we should be proud of being able to conduct a search where there was 5 IRB,s on the water (3 ours), 2 jetskis (1 crewed by a Newport member) and 2 duty officers from Newport, plus a number doing land based searches.
- All members involved have had contact from TIPS and other follow ups, we will continue to keep an eye on them.
