Director of Finance & Sponsorship Committee's Report

 Sponsorship Opportunities - Newport Surf Life Saving Club (newportsurfclub.com.au)

- Pleasing month for income month with lots of Club activity. Bar, function, and events (back to beach) income of \$9K. We've seen 27% of last year's Membership fees be received in Sep at \$24K. The Basin camp brought in \$4.5K. Clothing sales, Sponsorship, hall hire and board hire make up the rest. Total Revenue of \$42.5K vs \$18K last year. Last year included \$6K of COVID / Job saver grants in Sep.
- Expenses a bit lower than prior year, mainly due to the timing difference with SLSNSW Capitation costs of \$15K in August vs September prior year. Variable expenses associated with the Bar and functions and SRC camp were up in line with revenue as you'd expect, although the food costs for the Back to the Beach function were paid in August.
- Normal expenses were well controlled but include operational costs of the club such as Wages, Depreciation, Cleaning and R&M / Rescue supplies to get ready for the upcoming season.
- Other Expenses incurred included costs for Purchasing clothing stock (some more Nipper rashies and a new stock of club hats (caps) to sell.
- At this stage last year we had received approx. \$35K of COVID grants from the govt vs \$0 this year.
- Profit of approx. \$18K for the month. YTD position is \$10K worse than last year, although there is a favourable timing difference of approx. \$16K regarding membership subscriptions which we are seeing earlier due to less uncertainty about the season. So effectively \$26K behind last year.
- A Sponsorship meeting has been held: an ad has gone out for the Sponsorship manager; Nippers have been reaching out to all their sponsors and have made great progress; Pool to Peak committee has also been in contact with their sponsors.
